**HELP and HEALING bring HOPE!**

HOPE HOUSE offers a home-like atmosphere to women, transitioning out of emergency housing after rescue from situations of enslavement and oppression.

The focus at HOPE HOUSE shifts from the immediacy of staying safe to personal growth and self-esteem development.

HOPE HOUSE, which accommodates four adult women plus staff, is in a confidential location in San Diego County, CA.

HOPE HOUSE is supported by social service agencies from the Bilateral Safety Corridor Coalition (BSCC), the Soroptimists International, and permanent on-site staff from the SAVE Project.

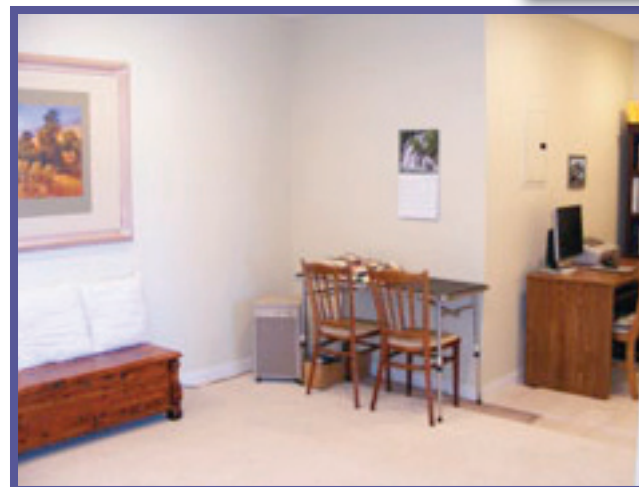
A woman is referred by a BSCC caseworker and must be both drug and alcohol free. She is interviewed by Hope House staff before signing an agreement.

Women may stay up to 24 months while they receive counseling, legal and medical-related services. The goal is to achieve independent living by utilizing vocational or educational opportunities.

HOPE HOUSE residents, supported by professional and caring staff, are able to take concrete steps toward a secure future.

Services include:

- counseling and needs assessment;
- health and wellness training;
- ESL and life-management skills;
- verbal, reading, writing and math skills;
- computer training;
- resume writing and interviewing skills;
- job search and employment guidance.
